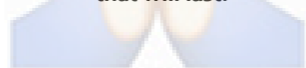

The ongoing inter-church Alpha course is an exciting option, to begin again in Jan 2025 - led by Ernestine McKeever and Brian Taylor from Portstewart.

Another complementary approach is through an understanding of the biblical origins and history of the Rosary prayers. **Continues Wed 8th May at 7.30 p.m. in Chapelfield**

A simple toolkit for this will be discussed and trialled in the parish, centred on 'conversation in the spirit'. Attentively listening to one another, and praying together, we hope to learn how to approach the problem highlighted in the Derry diocesan synodal report of 2022 - of a 'widespread desire... for adult faith formation... for individuals ... and for parents of children participating in the sacraments'.
