Parish Pastoral Council Minutes of Meeting held on Tue. 3rd May.

1. Synodality Responses were briefly reflected upon and decision was made to spend all of the next P.C. Meeting reflecting on the responses given at those Synodality Meetings.
2. Parish Survey: It was decided to focus presently on the above responses at this point of time as it was very much a survey in itself, that needs focusing on presently. The Parish Survey will take place at a date to be fixed at next Meeting.
3. Speakers have been arranged for the Parish Pentecost Triduum to be held in St John's Church on the evenings of Monday 30th May: Tuesday 30th May: Wednesday 1st June With All Day Expositon of the Blessed Sacrament/Rosary and Benediction at 6pm- in St John's Church, to begin the Triduum on Sunday 29th May (Ascencion Sunday), inviting the Holy Spirit to 'Fall afresh on All'.
4. A Parish Celebration of Baptised Babies, for all babies who were baptised in any of the Three Churches in the Parish from Easter Sunday 2021 until Easter Sunday this year 2022. Invite will be sent to the parents and family members to attend. Date fixed for this celebration. Trinity Sunday 12th June 2022 at 3pm in St John's Church, Coleraine.

Walk With Me – Parish Leadership Youth Ministry Mentoring.

Throughout the month of May 2022, Derry Diocesan Youth Ministry is hosting 'WALK WITH ME', a four week mentoring programme for parish and volunteer leaders working with young people (13-18yr olds) in the Derry Diocese.

The programme is for everyone in the Derry Diocese who is involved in youth ministry, who would like to be involved or who would like to find out about youth ministry in the diocese.

The four online sessions will provide an opportunity to come together in prayer and support, celebrate and share best practice and strategically plan Youth Ministry in the Diocese.

The mentoring programme will explore:

- What young people have said during the synodal pathway listening sessions in the diocese:
- How does Pope Francis talk about Youth Ministry? What is the approach we should be taking with the young people in our parishes.
- Practical ideas of what help and programmes are on offer in the Diocese and suggestions for all parishes; and
- Making a strategic plan for your parish on what you think could be achieved.

What is required? Four group sessions via zoom. Some pre-reading and videos to view. Commitment to one-to-one work to develop your plans for youth ministry; and Supporting your peers – invitation to 'buddy up' with another participant.
