Parish Draw 2025

The draw for January & February Is due to take place on Tuesday 18th February, after the 10am Mass.

The Parish Draw is a vital source of income for the Parish and assists with the everyday running of Parish expenses. We need the draw to take place as it is not an optional activity, but vital, otherwise the Parish would be running at a loss in the Year-to-year overhead expenses.

The Parishioners are a credit in their support of the draw over the years, and the promoters have been selfless in their effort to bring more members into the draw.

At Present we are about 65 members short in 2024. So, you may know of someone who might be interested as there is still time to join. Feel free to call into the Sacristy after Mass at the weekends, and weekdays (Tuesdays & Thursdays until 12 noon)

The Draw can be paid in one instalment of £60, 3 equal instalments of £20 or £5 per month. Each month a total of £1000 is paid out in prizes i.e. 1x£500, 4X£100 & 2x£50 and for all paid up members we have an Free draw in December making a total of £13,000 paid out Annually.
