The official liturgical schedule for Pope Leo XIV's for the month of May 2025.

May 18th: Inaugural Mass in St. Peter's Square Pope Leo XIV will be formally installed as Bishop of Rome with a Eucharistic Celebration in St. Peter's Square at 10 a.m. on Sunday, May 18, the Fifth Sunday of Easter. This Mass marks the official beginning of his Petrine Ministry and will include the conferral of the Fisherman's Ring and the pallium, traditional symbols of papal authority.

May 20th: Pope Leo will visit the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, where he will pray at the tomb of the Apostle Paul. This "taking possession" of one of Rome's four papal basilicas is a customary act for new popes.

May 25th: The Sixth Sunday of Easter, Pope Leo will celebrate the Eucharist and be installed on the cathedral — the bishop's chair — at the Basilica of St. John Lateran, the official cathedral of the Bishop of Rome.

May 31st: Holy Mass at 10 a.m. in St. Peter's Basilica, during which Pope Leo XIV will ordain new priests for the first time as pontiff.
