Join thousands of people from around Ireland and beyond for the All-Ireland Rosary Rally on June 1st. The day begins at 9.30am with a Conference in St. John's Centre. Speakers include Fr Brendan Kilcoyne, Fr Joseph Mary Deane CFR, and Sr Ana Margarita Lanzas SCTJM. Then there is a chance to meet over 20 apostolates from around Ireland in St John Centre from 1130am. The keynote speaker, Mother Adela Galindo, is coming from Miami, Florida, and she will speak in the Basilica at 1pm. The Stations of the Cross will be outside from 2pm, followed by the Rosary procession. Mass will commence at 3pm in the Basilica and will include the anointing of the sick. - 1. Penitential Service in St Johns Church: Monday 20th May at 7pm. Several Priests will be in attendance. All welcome. Decided to host this service on a quarterly parish in the parish throughout the year. Confession also available after Thursday morning mass in St Johns. After the 12noon weekday mass in Aghadowey and Dunboe.
- 1. Trinity Sunday 26th May (1st World Childrens Day) Invitation to parents/guardians of all children baptized in the parish since Pentecost Sunday of 2023. (28/5/23). To bring their baptized child along with the godparents for a short ceremony of thanksgiving at St John's Church, Coleraine at 3pm on that day of the 26th May 24.
- 2. Corpus Christ 1st/2nd June 24. Fr Peter O Kane. (appointed in September 2023 Derry Diocesan Trainer in Evangelisation and Adult Faith Development) Fr Peter will celebrate and speak at all masses in the parish on the weekend of 1st/2nd June 24.
- 3. Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus: Friday 23rd June at 7pm. Mass of the Anointing of the elderly and sick. This Mass will take place in St Johns Church. All welcome.
- 4. World Day of Grandparents and elderly. Sunday 28th July 24. Invite volunteers from grandparents and their grandchildren to read on the day as well as Prayers of the Faithful and partake in the offertory procession. Contact parish office or sacristy.
